GENERAL

Edictum Law & Co. - Data related to your visit of our website or electronic mailers and updates that we may send to you from time to time.
- In the case of employees, Edictum Law consultants and interns: certain financial information such as your bank account details and biometric information such as fingerprints.
- Your contact with us, such as: an email or letter you send to us and other records of any contact you may have with us.
- Your account information, such as: dates of payments made, owed or received.

HOW WE USE THIS INFORMATION

Unless required by applicable data protection regulation, Edictum Law will not disclose, use, give or distribute any personal information to third parties for any purposes other than to those third parties that need to know, and such need to know is necessary for delivery of services in relation to your engagement or employment with us.

We may disclose personal information to third parties where:

- You have consented to us sharing your personal information in this way.
- We are under a legal, regulatory or professional obligation to do so (for example, in order to comply with applicable laws) or to protect the rights and interests, property, or safety of Edictum Law, our clients or others.

- It is relevant in the circumstances to disclose the information to our clients, your employer or place of business, and your professional advisers.
- We may use third party service providers to provide services that involve data processing, for example archival, auditing, professional advisory (including legal, accounting, financial and business consulting), technology, website, research, banking, payment, client contact, data processing, insurance, forensic, litigation support, and security services.
